In response to the global call for action by SMUG (Sexual Minorities Uganda), a network of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and intersex people's organizations based in Uganda, activists from around the world are organizing actions to condemn the Anti-Homosexuality Bill that's been proposed in the Ugandan Parliament.

This assault on the basic human rights for the Ugandan LGBT would:

- Send anyone who has knowledge of a person engaging in homosexuality to prison
- Mandate a life sentence for anyone touching someone with the "intent of committing the act of homosexuality"
- Institute the **DEATH PENALTY** for HIV+ people and "serial offenders" who commit "aggravated homosexuality"
